



## Title I Pre-K

### **Now Accepting Applications!**

The MSD of Martinsville is currently accepting applications for pre-kindergarten through a federal funding program called Title 1. Title 1 funding reduces the expense of pre-kindergarten for students. If selected, students would receive their pre-k education at either a discounted rate or at no-cost.

Please note that space is limited. Applications do not guarantee acceptance into the program.

Title 1 Pre-K is a full-day program for students who reside within one of the following Title I school areas:

- Brooklyn Elementary
- Charles L. Smith Fine Arts Academy
- Paragon Elementary
- Poston Road Elementary
- South Elementary

Application requirements for Title I Pre-K include:

- Children must be at least 4 years old by August 1, 2018.
- Children must reside within the boundaries of one of the Title I schools listed above.
- Students selected for the program would be assigned to the school closest to where they reside.
- Parents must be willing to provide transportation.

Selection for the program is based on student need as determined by an age appropriate assessment given through the Title I department.

Parents or guardians who apply for this pre-k opportunity must complete online enrollment by June 1, 2018.
