

Families and Guests of the Class of 2021,

We are excited to celebrate our Martinsville High School graduates with you on Friday, May 28th at 7:00 PM! Prior to our recognition of our graduates, the MSD of Martinsville would like to make sure everyone is aware of our mask policy since it will be different depending on our venue. On April 29th, 2021 Governor Eric Holcomb extended the mask mandate for K-12 buildings and facilities in Executive Order 21-12 that runs until May 31, 2021. This is regardless of vaccination status.

Masks will be required at all times, regardless of vaccination status, for individuals over the age of 3 unless there is a mask exemption due to a medical condition, mental health condition, or disability that prevents wearing of a face mask. Additionally, masks will be required if utilizing one of the shuttles. Masks will be provided to those who do not have one.

Graduates/Individuals Participating in Ceremony

Graduates will wear masks at all times except when crossing the stage to receive their diplomas. Individuals speaking during the event will also be permitted to remove their masks while they are speaking. Both of these circumstances have been approved by the Morgan County Department of Health.

Masks will be required if riding a shuttle or walking/cutting through MHS. You will be asked to have a mask with you at all times while inside Siderewicz Field and encouraged to wear a mask when walking around and not socially distanced from non-household/non-family members. Families and guests are encouraged to sit together and away from non-household/family members. Masks will be provided to those who do not have one.

Graduates/Individuals Participating in Ceremony

Graduates will wear masks during the processional and recessional. Graduates will be able to remove masks once seated and when walking across the stage. Individuals speaking will have masks removed.
