

MSD of Martinsville COVID-19 Public Event

Guidance



Masks

Outdoors: Masks are **optional** at all times when outdoors. Social distancing should be observed.

Indoors: Masks are **optional** at all times, but are **recommended** for individuals who are unvaccinated. Social distancing from non-family or non-household members is **recommended** especially if unvaccinated, even if masked.

Symptomatic Individuals

Vaccinated AND unvaccinated individuals should monitor daily for any of the below COVID-19 symptoms. Individuals who unusually exhibit one or more of the following symptoms should remain home and follow COVID-19 protocol by either: A. going to be tested, B. isolate for 10 days from symptom onset, or C. seek doctor's clearance.

- Fever (100 degrees or higher) or chills
- Sore throat
- Cough or shortness of breath
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea or abdominal pain
- Vomiting or nausea
- Congestion

Close Contacts

Individuals who are close contacts of a positive individual should refrain from attending any public event on MSD of Martinsville property if they are unvaccinated and they themselves have not tested positive in the last 90 calendar days unless:

14 Days– 14 days has passed from the date they were last around the positive individual, the close contact has not tested positive, and has remained symptom free.

10 Days– 10 days has passed from the date they were last around the positive individual, the close contact has not tested positive, and has remained symptom free. The close contact will also be required to wear a mask and be socially distanced 6 feet at all times from all other guests.

7 Days– 7 days has passed from the date they were last around the positive individual and has remained symptom free. The close contact has a negative PCR test that is administered after exposure day 5. The close contact will also be required to wear a mask and be socially distanced 6 feet at all times from all other guests.
