



WHAT IS ILEARN?

ILEARN is Indiana's online computer-adaptive assessment designed to measure your child's proficiency of the Indiana Academic Standards. It fulfills both state and federal legislative requirements as the accountability assessment for Indiana students.

How does a computer-adaptive assessment benefit my child?

The test adapts to each student's mastery of the content throughout the assessment. Every time a student answers a question, his or her response helps determine the next question presented. The difficulty of the test will adjust to each student's skills, providing a better measure of what each student knows and can do. The online testing system is more accessible to students who require features or accommodations while testing. New tools and resources are available to help students show what they know.
